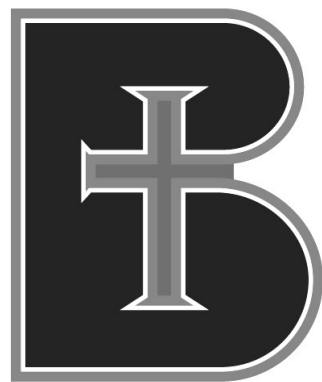

DR. EDWARD SRI, author of “A Biblical Walk Through the Mass,” will present twice as the keynote speaker.

Sri has authored more than 10 books and is the best-selling author of two Catholic books, “The New Rosary in Scripture: Biblical Insights for Praying the 20 Mysteries” (Servant) and “The Da Vinci Deception: 100 Questions About the Facts and Fiction of The Da Vinci Code” (Ascension Press), co-authored with Mark Shea. He also wrote “Men, Women and the Mystery of Love: Practical Insights on John Paul II’s Love and Responsibility” (Servant) on male-female relationships, “Mystery of the Kingdom: On the Gospel of Matthew” (Emmaus Road), “Queen Mother: A Biblical Theology of Mary’s Queenship” (Emmaus Road) and “Dawn of the Messiah: The Coming of Christ in Scripture” (Servant). Sri also is a co-author of the popular apologetics series “Catholic for a Reason.”

He is a professor of scripture and theology at the Augustine Institute in Denver, Colo. and serves as a visiting professor at Benedictine College in Atchison, Kan. Sri holds a doctorate from the Pontifical University of St. Thomas Aquinas in Rome. He resides with his wife Elizabeth and their six children in Littleton, Colo.

JENNIFER SCHMIDT will share the story of her daughter, Gianna, who lived 33 minutes after her birth, and God’s transforming power in the experience. Jennifer is a licensed clinical professional counselor.

Her family has shared their story in various publications, with one feature story earning recognition as the National Right to Life’s 11th Annual Excellence in Journalism award. She will present “Illuminating the Sanctity of Life: Persuasion When Diagnoses are Determined Prenatally” at the fall 2011 Center for Ethics and Culture Conference at the University of Notre Dame. She lives with her husband and two sons in Olathe, Kan.



BR. CAJETAN CUDDY, O.P., will speak on “Sin, Grace and the Cross: The Catholic Life As The Light of the World.” A convert to Catholicism from evangelical Protestantism, he is a graduate of Franciscan University of Steubenville. Br. Cajetan is a Dominican friar of the Province of St. Joseph currently assigned to the Dominican House of Studies in Washington, D.C., where he is studying for the priesthood.
